Community Garden and Earth Day

Happy Spring! Our "Spring Events" postcard will be arriving in the neighbor's mailboxes this week. One of our biggest and most exciting projects is the **Community Garden** we are working on in partnership with Denver Urban Gardens, Jeffco Schools, Green Gables Elementary School, Westwoods Church and the Southern Gables Neighborhood Association.

In September, Sustainable Southern Gables applied for a grant from the City of Lakewood's "Neighborhood Participation Program" for \$35,000 to build and start up the Garden. We will be notified on April 11, 2016 whether or not we will receive grant funds. In the meantime, our garden has been a class project for students in a CU-Denver Landscape Architecture class. The students have drawn up beautiful plans (which include community garden plots, an outdoor classroom/meeting space, butterfly gardens and more).

Sustainable Green Gables is excited to share the proposed Community Garden plans, funding updates, and next steps at our 3rd Annual Earth Day Seed and Plant Swap on Friday, April 22. 2016 at Green Gables Elementary Cafeteria. Bring a pot luck dish to share; swap extra seeds, seedlings, and perennials you have thinned out; hear the Community Garden updates, enjoy kid's activities; and kick off Spring with neighbors. Sustainable Southern Gables Leaf Raking and Composting Day has been selected to receive a City of Lakewood 2016 Community Sustainability Ward!!
